Elementary School (grades 1 through 5)

Drama/Team Work/Social Skills

Divide your students into groups and assign each student to one of the characters/roles below. Students must create two skits, which may be acted out in front of the entire class:

- 2. A situation where an accident is prevented

After each group's skip is acted out, ask the audience to discuss the differences between skits one and two and share what safety rules were followed and which ones were not.
